Documentation and compliance:To create a detailed IDP document that complies with UGC guidelines and envisages the delivery of quality education with multidisciplinary approach in higher educational institutions (HEIs).

Internal approval process: To submit the IDP document for internal approval within the college. This involves presenting the document to college's governing body for their approval.

Submission to UGC: To submit the IDP along with necessary documents as per prescribed format to UGC after internal approval process.
