ABOUT THE COLLEGE

With a vision to provide educational opportunities for girls, Mrs. Kripa Devi conceived the idea of establishing an educational institution and laid the foundation of Raghunath Girls' (P.G.) College under the Kripa Devi Trust Fund Society on February 27, 1929, with the noble aim of promoting women's education in the area. The institution started with just five students and has since progressed into a pioneering and reputed institution in Meerut City, now catering to nearly 5,000 students.

Building on its strong foundation, we strive to make learning an enriching, fulfilling, and enjoyable experience through a multidisciplinary approach. Our focus is on ensuring consistent and catalytic improvements in the overall development of the college, its students, and faculty, while also paving the way for innovative ideas and critical thinking to promote a value-based academic environment. Today, the college stands tall, having been declared one of the best girls' colleges in Uttar Pradesh after successfully completing four cycles of NAAC accreditation. Among these, the college has been accredited with an "A" grade twice and was recently awarded a "B+" grade with a score of 2.53. Additionally, it was conferred the prestigious 'CPE' status in 2004 and "College of Excellence" status by the UGC in 2014.

DEPARTMENT OF SOCIOLOGY

The Department of Sociology was introduced at the undergraduate level in 1962, at the postgraduate level in 1965, and research programs began in 1975 with the vision of promoting both social and academic growth among students. The department aims to foster social innovation and research, deepen the understanding of human dignity and worth, and instill values of social justice, service, humanity, integrity, and competence. Over 28 research scholars have successfully completed their Ph.D. work, and more than 20 Ph.D. research projects are currently ongoing under the supervision of faculty members. The faculty has actively organized various national seminars, completed major and minor research projects, and contributed to academic publications, including books. Furthermore, department alumni have secured positions in various teaching and professional sectors.

ABOUT THE SEMINAR

Gender inequality remains a significant global challenge, disproportionately affecting women and girls by limiting their access to education, healthcare, employment, and leadership opportunities. In many parts of the world, including India, gender discrimination begins before birth, with female foeticide, child marriage, and restricted economic opportunities reinforcing cycles of poverty and inequality. Recognizing this, the United Nations has prioritized gender equality through the Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs), particularly SDG 5, which aims to eliminate discrimination and ensure equal rights for women. Other goals, such as SDG 4 (Quality Education) and SDG 8 (Decent Work and Economic Growth), also play crucial roles in empowering women by promoting education, fair wages, and economic independence.

India has made significant progress through initiatives like Beti Bachao Beti Padhao (BBBP) to promote girls' education, Mahila Shakti Kendra for women's empowerment etc which strengthens workplace rights for women. However, achieving true gender equality requires a multi-dimensional approach—one that integrates legal reforms, economic opportunities, and societal change. Governments, civil society, and individuals must collaborate to dismantle barriers and create a more inclusive world where every individual, regardless of gender, has the opportunity to thrive. Through sustained efforts and global cooperation, gender equality can become a reality.
