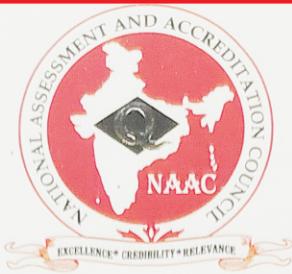

COLLEGE PROFILE

A premier girls' institution in Uttar Pradesh, Raghunath Girls' Post-Graduate College is situated in the urban heart of the city of Meerut where the pursuit of learning is taken seriously. Ranked No. 1 by the UP Government in 1994, the College was Accredited with 'A' in 2011 and re-accredited with grade 'A' in 2016 with CGPA 3.13, It successfully faced its 4th cycle of Accreditation in September 2022. The college has been conferred with the status of College of Excellence in 2014 by UGC.

Rising to its present stature from very humble beginning, Raghunath Girls' Post-Graduate College was founded in 1929 by Shrimati Kripa Devi in memory of her late husband, Lala Raghunath Ji under the Kripa Devi Trust Fund as a small school in 1936. In 1948, it became a graduate college in Humanities and in 1958 the Science stream was introduced. It acquired the Post-Graduate status in Humanities in 1959 and in Science in 1982. Commerce at the graduate level was established in 1993 and post-graduation in 2005. The college also offers vocational courses in Food Science & Quality Control and Computer Application granted by the UGC. Since 2015-16 B. Voc in Yogic Science and Applied Clinical Psychology have been granted under DDUKK. All the departments are equipped with e-classrooms of their own.

Incentives for Excellence: The students of the college are given incentives as encouragement in the form of prizes, medals, citations for excelling in academic and co-curricular and extra-curricular activities. The name of the academic achievers are also inscribed on the Honour Board. In this way the college aspires to establish a system of Quality Assurance which would, on a continuous basis evaluate and monitor the quality of education and training imparted at the institute. The improved teaching learning process has already gained for the college the status of **College of Excellence in 2014**. Teachers appointed in various departments under self-finance scheme have been granted special financial aid from the U.P. Govt. in recognition of their exemplary performance in their respective departments.

Management & Governance: The College has a prestigious & erudite managing committee, Shri. Vinay Kumar Modi is presently the President and Mr. Puneet Nath & Dr. Rahul Mithal are Secretary & Joint Secretary respectively.

Faculty & Students: The College is committed to being a community that fearlessly pursues excellence, invests in developing well groomed students and prepares them to make a difference in the world. It has an outstanding & dynamic faculty comprised of permanent, ad-hoc, contractual and guest teachers. The college has 121 teachers of them 76 have doctorate degrees and the rest are striving towards it. The number of students is around 5000. Special facilities are provided to research scholars. At present there are 50 approved research guides with 109 scholars working under their guidance.

Library: The College is proud of its well-equipped library, spread across four floors, comprising a journal room, a research section, a students' reading room and a book bank with a fully computerized open access system. It has around one lakh books under lending, text books and reference books with 65000 titles, 4300 bound journals, 628 Rare books and subscriptions to 30 Indian and International Journals, 23 magazines and 12 newspapers. It provides access to e-Journals via INFLIBNET & DELNET. It also has photocopying facility for the students.

Auditorium: Facilitates presentation in terms of excellent sound and backdrop. The auditorium is centrally air conditioned and has 400 seats on the ground and first floor. It has a full screen facility to showcase films & documentaries.

Office: The office of the college is computerized and is manned by an efficient team of ministerial staff. Besides ministerial staff members it has efficient support staff as well.

1. POLICY ON CODE OF PROFESSIONAL ETHICS AND CONDUCT FOR STUDENTS

2. POLICY DOCUMENT FOR GREEN CAMPUS INITIATIVES

Green Protocol of the College

- Promote effective water management by rainwater harvesting or recharging.
- Regular inspection of taps for draining & repair to avoid loss of portable water
- Spread awareness amongst society about waste and e-waste management.
- Improve awareness about Renewable energy resources and importance of energy conservation.
- Reduce the use of disposable items in all functions.
- Development of the process of giving earthern/ceramic pots with plants instead of bouquet to guests on various occasion.
- Adopt and promote power saving electrical equipments such as LED Bulbs and solar power equipments such as lights, geysers.
- Promote use of e-copies, e-assignments and e-documents to minimize use of paper.
- Plantation of trees on important day of celebration.
- Promote organic vegetable and medicinal plant cultivation. Promote Biocompost/vermicompost unit on and off the campus.
- Support and protect indigenous diversity and their documentation.
- Ban on the use of single use plastic in canteen and in all the meetings of the college.
- Conduct awareness programs and workshops on the harmful impact of single use plastic.
- Encourage students to spread importance of banning plastic, water and energy conservation, waste management in the community they live.
- Encourage faculty, non-teaching staff and students to avoid use of plastic water bottles, bags, folders, files etc and instead use alternative solutions like use of paper folders, cloth/jute bags and files.

- Assures facilities and services that caters to the needs of the differently abled in the campus and ensures access to these facilities to them.
- Provides equality of opportunity for them in their development, progression and finally recruitment.
- Ensures appropriate alternative examination arrangements, provision of notes, lectures, e-contents and other external resources.
- Rectifies any problem through Grievance Redressal cell or committee for differently abled.
- Ensures inclusiveness in working, learning and teaching environment to students and staff with disabilities.
- Confirms that the committee schedules regular meeting for updating and awaring the differently students and staff with Government schemes and facilities.

4. ANTI-RAGGING POLICY

The anti-ragging policy adopted by the institution takes care of curbing the menace of Ragging in Higher Education Institution based on the Guidelines provided by the UGC and Chaudhary Charan Singh University, Meerut. As per the policy. :

- The college constitutes an Anti-Ragging committee with a faculty Convenor and other members of faculty and students headed by Principal to monitor and vigilantly inspect various aspects related to the menace of Ragging.
- Students and parents are supposed to fill an affidavit at the time of admission taking an oath that their ward will not indulge in any type of ragging activity in the college campus.
- Any conduct by any student whether by words spoken or written or by an act which has the effect of teasing, treating or handling with rudeness any student, is prohibited.
- Student or students indulge in rowdy or undisciplined activities, which causes or likely to cause annoyance, hardship, physical or psychological harm or apprehension will face disciplinary action.
- Asking any Student to do any act which such students will not in the ordinary course do or which has the effect of causing or generating a sense of shame or torment or embarrassment or adversely affect the physique or psyche of such student, is prohibited.
- Any act of financial extortion or forceful expenditure burden put on student by other students, is prohibited.
- Any act of physical abuse including all variants of it: sexual abuse, lewd acts, gestures, causing bodily or any other danger to health, is prohibited.
- Any act that affects the mental health and self-confidence of any other student with or without an intent to derive a sadistic pleasure or showing off power or authority by a student over any other student, is prohibited.

A student found guilty by the committee will attract one or more of the following punishments depending on the facts and circumstances and nature and gravity of the incident of ragging as imposed by Anti-ragging Committee:-

- Suspension from attending classes and academic privileges.
- Debarring from appearing in any test/ examination
- Withholding results
- Suspension and expulsion from the hostel and mess
- Cancellation of admission in serious cases.

An appeal against any of the orders of punishments enumerated herein above shall be to the Principal of the Institute. Her decision will be final in the matter.

5. POLICY DOCUMENT FOR IDENTIFICATION, ACTIVITIES AND MONITORING OF SLOW AND ADVANCED LEARNERS

Raghunath Girls' Post Graduate College is itself one of the premiere girls' colleges in the state by providing quality teaching learning to students. It offers learner centric teaching -learning along with number of co-curricular, extracurricular, extension and outreach activities for students from diverse background for their all round and holistic development.

Each type of student has different learning aptitudes and learning habits. Therefore, the objectives of the assessment of learning levels of the students and conduction of activities for them is to :-

- Identify slow learners and advance learners in the class
- Ensure slow and advanced learners are taken care of as per their needs
- Develop significant strategies and their implementation to benefit both the slow and advanced learner

- Encourage advanced learners to be excellent achievers
- Boost the confidence of slow learners and help them out for improvement in their academics
- Minimize the gap between slow learners and fast learners

A. Identification Methods of Slow Learners and Advanced Learners

- Based on the following parameters , at the entry level a student must be assessed on basis of:-
 1. Performance in preceding examination
 2. Interest in chosen current subject
 3. Involvement in classroom teaching learning
 4. Learning speed of the student
 5. Every faculty member should conduct class test (objective type test which can be online also) to identify different category of learners
- Based on the above parameters a report is to be prepared for the entire class i.e. 100% learners
 1. Students securing below 40% would be identified as Slow Learners
 2. Student with marks between 40%-70% would be identified as Average Learners
 3. Students securing marks above 70% would be identified as Advanced Learners

B. Activities

I) For Slow Learner

- Provision of bridge course
- Provision for first year students should be made on weekly basis in the time-table for tutorials, interactions, remedial classes and personal counselling
- Bilingual explanations and discussions
- Provision for simplified lecture notes on course material
- Revision of topics and practical work
- Special hints and techniques to answer a question
- Guest lecture to be arranged
- Provision of question bank and solving of university question papers
- Enhancement of communication skills
- Regular Mentor-mentee/Parent teacher meeting

II) For Advanced Learners

- Encouraging them to participate in group discussion, debates, quizzes and other interdepartmental and intradepartmental activities
- Give assignments based on case studies and latest innovation etc
- Encourage participation in national/international seminars/conferences/professional events
- Career guidance for competitive examination and selection of career

- Personal counselling as and when the student turn up for any guidance
- Enroll such learners into MOOC/SWAYAM advance courses
- Meritorious students are felicitated every year with cash prizes and certificates
- Guest lecture on advanced topic to be arranged
- Encourage to write poems, articles, short stories for college departmental magazines
- Internship platform to be provided through MOU's with reputed industries/research industries
- Students to be engaged in IT enabled teaching-learning

C. Monitoring

- Each department/faculty to prepare report on the improvement in performance of slow learners after the university exam result is declared
- Analysis of the possibility/scope of further improvement in the slow learners
- Performance of average and advanced learners to be monitored and checked for further enhancement

D. Expected Outcome

- High academic performance of advanced learners
- Enhanced communication skills, interaction ability and subject clarity in advanced learners
- Increase in confidence to face the fast moving and competitive scenario
- Regularity and involvement of slow and average learners in classroom teaching-learning
- Improvement in the performance of slow learners in university exams
- High level of personal motivation in all the learners
- Better conceptual knowledge of chosen subject in all the learners
- Peer education strategies which will bridge the gap between slow learners and advanced learners

6. MENTORING POLICY

The college life of students is very challenging and fast including a lot of stress and pressures to achieve high position in academics, secure respectable jobs with good earnings and recognitions, maintain careers of their own choices and integrate learning of various skills with curriculum to ensure better performance and security in job. They have also to cope up with the information available through social media in this digital world. The higher education is becoming more and more complex and challenging due to fast developments in science and the sudden onset of various growing pandemics. These all factors creates a lot of anxiety and uncertainties among college students about their future success after college. It is a well-known fact that the turning point in the career of students is not only the curriculum topics but also their relationships with the mentors who may be their peers or teachers or professionals. Raghunath girls' postgraduate College, Meerut, admits girl students from various districts, villages and towns near Meerut with diverse social, cultural and economic backgrounds. Hence, in this college there is a requirement of continuous mentoring of students for their academic, social, personal and career upgradation. Moreover being the girls here, the students also need some emotional support as well. Considering these all needs of students, the college developed a Mentor-Mentee system where a group of students (Mentees) is assigned to a faculty (Mentor) from the same department preferably. The IQAC holds sessions every year for faculty members on mentoring. The college for its mentorship program has adopted the Following policy :-

Mentor Mentee Mechanism

- Faculty members (Mentors) will be assigned a group of 15 to 25 students per class preferably from the same department. Every faculty member starting from Principal to newly join will be assigned the role of a Mentor.
- The mentee once assigned to a mentor will continue with the same mentor till the end of the program of study. In case, if the mentor leaves the Institution, the information about the mentee should be shared with the new mentor.
- Every Year, First Year students will be added to the mentors list in place of graduating students. The mentor shall be provided the academic performance data and details of slow and advanced learners by the office.
- Mentors should help students to become self-reliant and confident.
- At least two meetings of mentors with their mentees will be scheduled per semester.
- Student Mentors will be assigned to slow learners in the format of a buddy system.
- Peer or student mentors will be felicitated at a suitable platform.

Responsibilities of Mentor

- Create a supportive and trusting environment
- Explore mentees career goals and provide information about Higher education and job opportunities.
- Review goals and objectives of the mentee; provide frank, honest, and constructive feedback.

- Assess mentees total performance - including skills, knowledge applied to practice, value, attitude and behavior
- Consistently take part in appropriate follow-up, documentation, and evaluation activities
- Meet with assigned mentees on a regular basis and maintain student activity logs
- If any student needs special academic tutoring, the mentor may direct the mentees to an appropriate faculty and may even ask the faculty to help their mentees in a particular area.
- Be a role model to walk the talk and exhibit the behaviors essential for success
- Maintain a brief but clear record of the notices and schedule of the meetings, that include discussions with students
- Listen to mentees issues and counsel for their health, mental and emotional well-being
- Maintain a professional relationship, doesn't intrude into the mentee's personal life Continuously monitor, counsel, guide and motivate the students in all academic matters

Responsibilities of Mentee

- Attend meetings regularly
- Be responsible for establishing the agenda for the conversation.
- Be respectful towards everyone and the mentor
- Share details of her performances in academic, extra-curricular activities, etc. with mentors
- Share her career plans and specific needs with mentor.
- Focus on the guidance or advice provided by the mentor.

Outcome of the Mentor-Mentee Program

- To empower students through imparting skills for self-awareness, self-management, social awareness and relationship management
- Identification of the learning abilities of the students and requirements of special needs.
- Identification of slow and advanced learners and take appropriate steps.
- Initiating new courses for career advancement of students based on student requirements.

Benefits of Mentor-Mentee Program

- Students get access to a support system during the crucial stages of their academic, professional and intellectual development.
- Enhances the students' confidence and challenges faced by them.
- Setting higher goals.
- Offers psychosocial support for the students.
- Help the students to develop the interpersonal skill
- Offers the students an exposure to diverse academic and professional perspectives, and experiences in various fields.
- Mentees get a direct access to powerful resources of the institution
- Offers the foundation for the students to reach greater heights in their professional lives.

STUDENTS SUPPORT SYSTEM

Hostel: A three floor, 250 bedded girls' hostel with a well-equipped mess stands in the college campus with all modern amenities which ensure the security and well-being of students coming from distant corners of the country. This hostel was inaugurated by the Honourable first President of India, Dr. Rajendra Prasad, on 3rd January 1961. The Goddess of learning Maa Saraswati and Lord Shiva are enshrined in temples within the hostel campus. It has a book store, a PCO and photocopying facility for the students. The hostel has facility of washing machine, gas and facility of sanitary napkin vending machine alongwith its incinerator for its inmates. Another sanitary napkin vending machine and its incinerator are also made available in the college premise for the day-scholars.

Psychological Testing and Counseling Cell: Available in both Online and Offline mode. Students' intelligence quotient and aptitude testing facilities are available. Remedial counseling is given to students for their emotional problems, tensions, adjustment problems, exam tensions and other psychological problems.

Medical Centre: It provides free medical aid to the staff & students. Homeopathic doctors are available at the Medical Centre in the college. First aid and emergency aid facilities are available at the Centre. Students are informed from time to time about infectious and contagious diseases, their prevention and cure. Free medicine is given for common & seasonal infections. Long-term medical treatment is also given to economically weaker section students free of cost. For allopathic treatment, the college has a MOU with Eves Hospital.

Scholarship, free books and Uniforms are provided to students from **economically weaker** sections. Details of various scholarships available are given in the last pages of Prospectus.

Special facilities for the physically challenged students like wheel chair, ramps, washrooms and use of lift are made available. Constant support and counseling regarding their career opportunities is given to them and awareness is created about their special needs by Equal Opportunity Cell in college.

Anti-ragging cell keeps constant vigil upon the students to keep them safe from the menace of ragging. And **Anti-Ragging Affidavit has been made mandatory for all Students and their Parents.** (It has been made mandatory by the UGC and by the Honourable Supreme Court that such student is to provide an affidavit on a Non-Judicial Stamp Paper of Rs 10/- duly attested by Oath Commissioner and the notary from her own home town to the effect that she would not indulge in any ragging activities. It has also been made mandatory for the parents to give a similar affidavit on a Non-Judicial Stamp Paper of Rs. 10/- duly attested by Oath Commissioner saying that their ward would not indulge in any such ragging activities. Separate formats have been designed for the students and parents which are available on the college website. **Aadhar No. is mandatory on both the Affidavits.**

Academic & Career Counseling & On-campus placement facilities: Opportunities are given to the students to seek employment by inviting various companies and institutions for their recruitment directly from the college. Students get regular suggestions and advice by the Academic and Career Counseling Cell in selecting professions suitable to their competence and interests.

Canteen: Fresh and healthy snacks are made available for the day scholars during the college hours.

Two Wheeler Stand: Specific parking area is provided for the students' two wheelers within the Campus.

Alumni Association: Final year students while leaving the college may remain connected with it by paying a life membership fee of Rs 1000/- or a ten year membership of Rs 600/-. They may also take its annual membership by paying Rs 150/-. For further details please check the website.

नई राष्ट्रीय शिक्षा नीति-2020 के अनुसार एन०सी०सी० में चयनित छात्राओं के लिए एन०सी०सी० एक माइनर इलेक्टिव कोर्स है, जिसे 15-26 आयु वर्ग वाले कैडेट्स स्नातक प्रथम वर्ष में ही ले सकते हैं। एन०सी०सी० में कैडेट्स को सैन्य प्रशिक्षण दिया जाता है। चयन प्रक्रिया बटालियन से निर्मित बोर्ड द्वारा की जाती है। प्रत्येक वर्ष में एन०सी०सी० व सरकारी-महाविद्यालय से सम्बन्धित गतिविधियों में 75% उपस्थिति होने पर तथा आवश्यक कैम्प करने पर ही 'बी' व 'सी' प्रमाणपत्र परीक्षा के लिए कैडेट परीक्षा फार्म भर सकता है। 'बी' व 'सी' प्रमाणपत्र परीक्षा में उत्तीर्ण होने पर एन०सी०सी० माइनर विषय के रूप में लेने वाले कैडेट्स के अंक विश्वविद्यालय द्वारा अंकतालिका में अंकित किये जाते हैं।

3. छात्राओं को अपना Identity Card प्रतिदिन अपने साथ लाना अनिवार्य है।
4. छात्राओं को अपनी समस्त कठिनाइयाँ, समस्या निवारण समिति को बतानी चाहिए।
5. छात्रवृत्ति व शुल्क-मुक्ति सम्बन्धी सभी आवेदन-पत्र कार्यालय में ही जमा कराने चाहिए।
6. पुस्तकालय की समस्त सुविधाओं का पूर्ण लाभ उठाने के लिए छात्राओं को पुस्तकालय के नियमों का पालन करना चाहिए।

 - (च) आधार कार्ड एवं पैन कार्ड की कॉपी अवश्य लाएँ।
 - (छ) ई-मेल आई०डी० एवं WhatsApp नम्बर अवश्य दें।

नोट:- मूल प्रमाण-पत्रों की वैधता का उत्तरदायित्व छात्रा का होगा। प्रमाण-पत्रों में किसी प्रकार की त्रुटि पायी जाने पर प्रवेश रद्द कर दिया जायेगा।

2. प्रवेश सम्बन्धी फार्म के पारित और हस्ताक्षरित हो जाने के उपरांत छात्र को प्रवेश शुल्क बैंक-स्लिप में भरकर शुल्क लिपिक से हस्ताक्षर कराकर विद्यालय-परिसर में स्थित यूनियन बैंक में उसी दिन जमा करके रसीद लेनी होगी, तत्पश्चात् उस पर शुल्क-लिपिक से पंजीकरण संख्या अंकित करानी होगी।

1. परिचय-पत्र छात्रा की इस विद्यालय की सदस्यता को प्रमाणित करता है।
2. प्रत्येक छात्रा को उस पर अपना चित्र चिपकाना होगा तथा परिचय-पत्र पर चीफ प्रॉफ्टर के हस्ताक्षर करवाने होंगे। एम०ए० के परिचय-पत्र सम्बन्धित विभागाध्यक्ष द्वारा हस्ताक्षरित होंगे।
3. यह परिचय-पत्र केवल एक वर्ष के लिए ही मान्य है।

परीक्षा एवं उपस्थिति (EXAMS AND ATTENDANCE)

- उपस्थिति : अभिभावक इस सम्बन्ध में विशेष सतर्क रहें- चौ० चरण सिंह विश्वविद्यालय के नियमानुसार छात्रा की उपस्थिति किसी एक विषय में भी 75 प्रतिशत से कम होने पर उसे परीक्षा में सम्मिलित नहीं होने दिया जायेगा। प्रत्येक मास की उपस्थिति कॉलिज की Website पर उपलब्ध होगी।
- परीक्षा तथा यूनिवर्सिटी एनरोलमेंट फॉर्म : यह फॉर्म प्रवेश समाप्त होने के बाद भरे जाते हैं, जो प्रथम वर्ष की समस्त छात्राओं को भरने होंगे। अन्य कक्षाओं में गत परीक्षा किसी अन्य विश्वविद्यालय से उत्तीर्ण करने वाली छात्राओं को भी विश्वविद्यालय का एनरोलमेंट-फॉर्म भरना होता है। ऐसी छात्राओं को पूर्व विश्वविद्यालय का Migration Certificate इसी के साथ मूल रूप (Original) से संलग्न करना है, अन्यथा फॉर्म स्वीकार नहीं होगा।
- न्यूनतम उत्तीर्णांक : यूनिवर्सिटी के नियमानुसार
- आन्तरिक परीक्षा : प्रत्येक सेमेस्टर में समय-समय पर आन्तरिक परीक्षा आयोजित की जाती हैं।

पुस्तकालय (LIBRARY)

स्नातक और स्नातकोत्तर स्तर पर पुस्तकालय का विशिष्ट स्थान है। प्रत्येक छात्रा को पुस्तकालय का लाभ उठाने के लिए इसकी सदस्यता लेनी होगी। परिचय-पत्र (Identity Card) प्रस्तुत करने पर लाइब्रेरियन द्वारा एक एनरोलमेंट कार्ड (Enrolment Card) दिया जायेगा। छात्रा इस कार्ड को भरकर अपने और अभिभावक के हस्ताक्षर सहित पुस्तकालय को लौटा देगी। इसके उपरांत छात्रा को रीडर्स टिकट (Reader's Ticket) प्रदान किये जायेंगे। एम०ए०, एम०ए०-सी० तथा एम०कॉम० की छात्रा को 4 रीडर्स टिकट दो वर्ष तथा बी०ए०, बी०ए०-सी० तथा बी०कॉम० की छात्रा को तीन रीडर्स टिकट तीन वर्ष के लिए दिये जायेंगे, जो कि प्रत्येक वर्ष के नवीनीकरण (Renewal) हेतु पुस्तकालय में परिचय-पत्र तथा सम्बन्धित वर्ष की फीस की रसीद (Admission Receipt) के साथ प्रस्तुत करने होंगे, तत्पश्चात् ही कोई पुस्तक लाइब्रेरी से प्राप्त की जा सकेगी।

विद्यालय में पंजीकृत शोध-छात्राओं को पुस्तकालय की सदस्यता दी जाती है तथा चार Reader's Ticket दिये जाते हैं जिन पर वे निश्चित समय के लिए पुस्तकें प्राप्त कर सकती हैं।

पुस्तक प्राप्ति (BOOK LENDING)

इस सम्बन्ध में प्रमुख बिन्दु निम्नलिखित हैं—

1. पुस्तकालय की प्रत्येक सदस्य रीडर्स टिकट (Reader's Ticket) की संख्या के अनुसार पुस्तकें ले सकती हैं।
2. पुस्तकालय से पुस्तक लेने के लिए छात्रा को निम्नांकित बातों का ध्यान रखना चाहिए—
 - (क) कार्ड कैटेलॉग (Card Catalogue) का प्रयोग करें।
 - (ख) कार्ड कैटेलॉग (Card Catalogue) में से आवश्यक पुस्तक का कॉल नम्बर (Call No.) लिखकर चिट तत्सम्बन्धी पेटिका में डाल दें।
 - (ग) छात्राएँ Computer के द्वारा पुस्तकें खोज सकती हैं।
3. छात्रा को रीडर्स टिकट (Reader's Ticket) के विनिमय में ही पुस्तक दी जायेगी। लौटा देने पर छात्रा को रीडर्स टिकट वापिस कर दिया जायेगा।
4. रीडर्स टिकट खो जाने पर छात्रा लाइब्रेरी को अविलम्ब लिखित सूचना देगी। 5/- प्रति टिकट दिये जाने पर ही पुनः रीडर्स टिकट प्रदान किये जायेंगे।
5. पुस्तक लेने से पूर्व छात्रा को भली प्रकार से निरीक्षण कर लेना चाहिए। यदि पुस्तक ठीक स्थिति में नहीं है, उसके पेज फटे हैं या पेज नहीं हैं, तो उसी समय लाइब्रेरियन को सूचित करें अन्यथा पुस्तक लेने वाली छात्रा को ही पुस्तकालय में नई पुस्तक देने का उत्तरदायित्व वहन करना पड़ेगा।

7. जिन पुस्तकों की माँग नहीं है, वे पुनः ली जा सकती हैं, किन्तु इस स्थिति में छात्राको अपने कार्ड पर पुनः पुस्तक प्राप्त करनी होगी।
8. निश्चित अवधि से अधिक समय तक पुस्तक रखने पर छात्रा से 1/- प्रतिदिन दण्ड स्वरूप लिया जायेगा।
9. संदर्भ पुस्तकें : 1. शब्द कोश (Dictionaries), 2. विश्वकोष (Encyclopedia), 3. वर्ष पुस्तकें (Year Books), 4. जीवन सम्बन्धी कोश (Biographical Dictionaries), 5. भू-चित्रावलियाँ (Atlas), 6. Journals घर के लिए नहीं दिये जाते हैं।
10. छात्राओं हेतु Book-Bank की सुविधा भी उपलब्ध है।
11. पुस्तकालय सम्बन्धी शिकायत अथवा सुझाव लिखकर पुस्तकालय में लगी सुझाव पेटी में डाले जा सकते हैं।

अभिभावक कृपया ध्यान दें

इस विवरणिका (Prospectus) में विद्यालय व प्रवेश सम्बन्धी सूचनायें दी गई हैं। अभिभावकों से अपेक्षा की जाती है कि वे फॉर्म भरने से पूर्व समस्त निर्देशों व सूचनाओं को ध्यानपूर्वक पढ़ेंगे।

Student Welfare Fund : This fund includes money taken from students as welfare fund and donation received from public.

2. **बुक बैंक (पाठ्य पुस्तक सहायता)-** विंविंअ०आ० (UGC) से प्राप्त सहायता एवं वाचनालय शुल्क से प्राप्त धन से विद्यालय में एक बुक-बैंक चलाया जाता है। योग्य एवं जरूरतमंद छात्राओं को इसमें से पूरे सत्र के लिए पाठ्य पुस्तकों प्रदान की जाती हैं। इसके लिए छात्रायें पुस्तकालय से प्रार्थना-पत्र प्राप्त कर लें। यह फार्म स्नातक छात्रायें पुस्तकालय के Issue Counter पर जमा करा दें। स्नातकोत्तर स्तर की छात्रायें अपने फार्म सम्बन्धित विभाग में जमा करा दें, इसके पश्चात् निश्चित शुल्क जमा करने पर छात्रा को पूरे सत्र के लिए पाठ्य पुस्तकों दी जाती हैं।

Book Bank : College runs Book Bank from the money received under UGC grant and Library fees. Deserving and needy students are given text books for the whole session. For this all students can take application from Library Issue Counter. UG students will submit it on the counter after filling the details and PG students will submit it in their respective departments. Students can get books issued after submittiong nominal fees in the library.

Bursary Book Grant : Based on merit, students get Rs. 100/- from Chaudhary Charan Singh University to purchase book which they have to give back to the library at the end of the session.

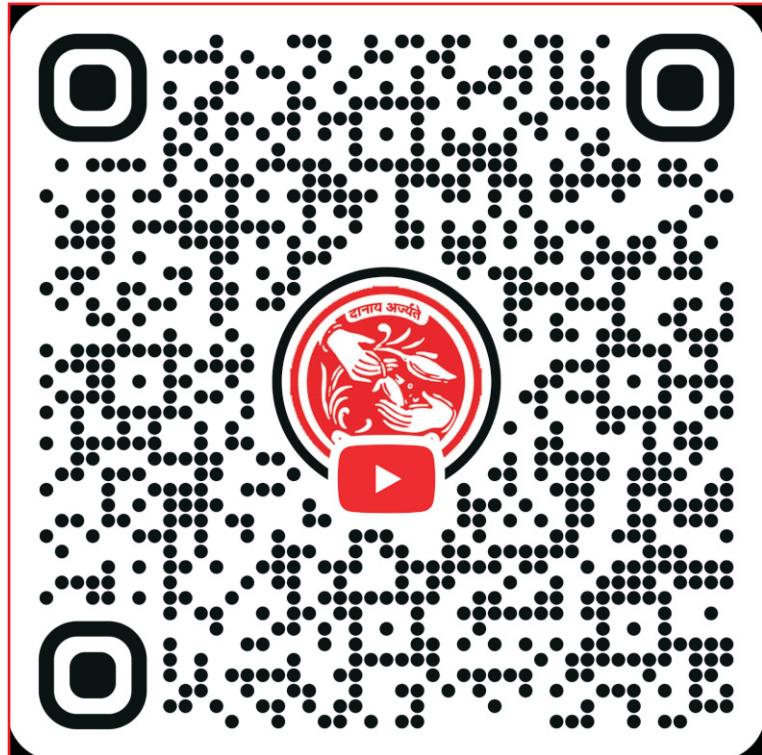

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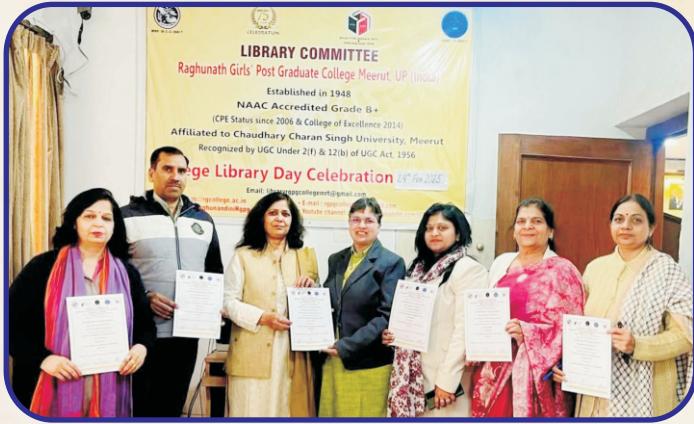
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
