6.2 Does the Department have a management Information System (MIS)

Yes, the college has an active MIS. It is sending regular data information to the UP Higher Education Commission, Allahabad, Education Department, Lucknow, Regional Education Directorate, Meerut and UGC, New Delhi.

It is annually uploading the RUSA & tri-monthly updating the AISHES formats and as and when the demand arises for other statistical details.

The college has created a complete students data base regarding their admissions, results and also the expenditures details of the college in every academic session.

6.3 Quality improvement strategies adopted by the Department for each of the following:

6.3.1 Curriculum Development

The college follows a Curriculum set by the CCS University as it is an affiliated to it but most of its HODs are members of University's Board of Studies and Academic Councils of different subjects so they contribute in its development according to the demands of the changing expectations from higher education in the society and the college in particular.

ICT, Communicative English, Physical Education, Computer Application, Food Sc., B.Voc in IT, Yogic Science and Clinical Psychology were subjects added to the University curriculum as a result of efforts in the same direction.

6.3.2 Teaching and Learning

ICT, modern audio-visual aids mainly PPT presentations and use of smart boards by professionally experts faculty members helps in disseminating knowledge to students in an interesting and captivating manner. National and international seminars, workshops and panel discussions develop confidence and initiative among them who coming from various rural & urban backgrounds get in tune with the latest knowledge available in their fields.

6.3.3 Examination and Evaluation

Along with the university annual and semester exams for the UG and PG respectively the college holds monthly tests, quiz and hourly programmes according to each department's own schedule. Internal exams for the PG students are also conducted twice in each semester and viva voce exams are conducted at the conclusion of each semester. Continuous evaluation by these methods helps the students to know their weaknesses and drawbacks and teachers help them through tutorials and extra classes, many times on one to one level also.

6.3.4 Research and Development

Most of the departments have 'Dissertation' as a compulsory paper for final year PG students. Where it is optional, teachers motivate the students to take it so that they become acquainted with the research techniques and methodology before entering a research programme. Teachers, themselves continue to attend refresher courses, national and international research oriented seminars and conferences and contribute papers. Teachers are also encouraged to apply for UGC and ICSSR sponsored minor and major projects and Post Doctoral fellowships. Each department has its own rich research library available to the students and fellow teachers for the whole academic session without any fee. Doctoral and Post doctoral Fellowship students who join the departments also teach and associate with PG students to help them complete for the JRF, NET, SLET and Pre-Ph.D. entrance Test.

Staff selection process and their recruitment are conducted by the Higher Services Commission in case of permanent employees because our college is an aided U.P. Govt. College affiliated to the CCS University.

Appointment of the temporary staff is done by the regular process of advertising the post, scrutinizing the applications, making merit, and then inviting for interview by the Principal and the Management Committee of the College.

6.3.8 Industry Interaction / Collaboration

Students of food science & Quality control are sent for "one month on the job training" in different food industries. Home science students are taken to different Textile industries and Tinned food factories for Industrial visit. Chemistry students are taken to visit different drugs, Chemicals, sugar, leather etc industries. Drawing & painting students are taken to different art Galleries. Zoology students are taken to Fisheries farms. Pol. Science students are brought into direct contact with Sabhasads, MLA's of the area through seminars and panel discussions organised in our college.

Admissions of UG & PG students in traditional courses are done through online registration at the university portal.

The University makes the merit list and sends it to our college according to the preference of the students and in numbers sanctioned for our college.

Our admission committee checks their originals and helps them in choosing the subjects of their choice according to their merit and availability of seats in our departments.

The entire process is transparent and computerised for future MIS requirements.

6.12 Activities and support from the Parent – Teacher Association

There is no tradition of Parent- Teacher association in our college. But most parents remain in contact with department teachers on telephone. Officially the parents are called in the college during Youth Festival if their wards are participating in events or are being honoured for their achievements. Parents are also summoned if their wards are found engaged in anti-social activities or in some disruptive behaviour, if they have a shortage of attendance or are failing in class tests and half yearly exams. With parents of PG students teachers are in direct contact through SMS and emails.

6.13 Development programmes for support staff

There is a rich tradition in our college of promoting the support staff to senior positions with added responsibility and emoluments once they enhance their academic and administrative qualifications. But this also involves a formal open recruitment process by the management and Principal of the college inviting applications for the same. The wards of the support staff also get concessions in their fees by the Principal and management committee and teaching staff liberally lends them study materials.

Contribution of IQAC in enhancing awareness about Student Support Services (2016-17)

IQAC has made all efforts in utilizing the following facilities created by the college as effective student support systems: like health center, guest house, canteen, grievance-redressal cell; students counseling and guidance cell; placement cell etc.:

- **Health Center / Fitness Centre:** There is a “Health care Centre” which run under the guidance of Medical Committee, provides Allopathic & Homeopathic medicines to students as well as the teaching and non-teaching staff. It provides first aid in case of any injury. Students are taken to the near-by hospital under the supervision of a teacher in case of any serious problem with the recommendation of the doctor. The Medical committee organizes talks by specialist doctors on girls’ related problems. Camps for Dental checkup, Eye checkup, bone density, blood group, Hemoglobin etc. are organized. Medical committee takes remedial action whenever any new epidemic spreads like Swine Flu etc by distributing precautionary medicines to students, teachers & non-teaching staff.
- **Guest House:** A fully furnished small Guest house for occasional stay of lady guest only is available.
- **Canteen:** College has a hygienically maintained canteen facility which provides tea, coffee etc along with fresh & cooked snacks at reasonable rates.
- **Grievance Redressal Cell:** Most of the problems of the students are solved by the teachers who are the members of Grievance Redressal Cell in consent with the Dean of Student Welfare, Chief Proctor and Principal.
- **Women Power Cell and Anti Sexual Harassment Cell** looks into these problems of the students.
- **Cleanliness and Beautification Committee** maintains the clean and green environment in the college.
- **Proctor Board/Anti Ragging Cell:** Disciplinary problems are solved by Proctors & Chief Proctor. Ragging is banned in the college premises.
- **Hostel Committee:** is referred for all the problems related to Hostel.
- **Academic & Career Counseling Cell:** The cell calls counsellors’ from different and new avenues in the Global market for the students of different disciplines. The members of the cell bring cuttings of different advertisements of jobs/courses and put them on the notice board of the cell as well as on career corner in the library reading room. They arrange interviews/entrance tests conducted by different organizations for the selection for jobs. They guide the students appearing for interviews/presentations by applying on their own level.
- **Psychological Testing & Counseling Centre:** Guides students in selecting the right courses and also counsels them on their personal & socio-economic problems.
- **Cultural & Co-curricular Activities Cell:** For the over-all personality development of students the co-curricular & cultural activities cell organizes various cultural programs, competitions and inter university and are very essential, especially in a girls college. It helps in job placement also.

Library, ICT and Physical Infrastructure / Instrumentation (2016-17)

- The College Library has almost 100,000 books with more than 65,000 titles, 2000 text books, 210 journals, 70 e-books, 15 news papers and 37 competitive exam journals. It has the INFLIBNET & DELNET facilities.
- All departments are aligned to the Central Library online.
- The Central Computer Lab is fully equipped with around 100 computers and an equal number of them are, in total, in all the departments for the use of students research work.
- All three Languages' Lab are established and working.
- Each department has its own seminar room with two class rooms each for holding UG & PG classes along with separate Lab facilities in the Practical Depts.
- Water coolers with purifiers are available to students on each floor.
- Student toilets are in each building block with ready-to-clean facility.
- There is a students' common room each in both the science and arts blocks.
- A.C. Auditorium with two students' gallery is equipped with the latest audio-visual infrastructure and sound and light system with a wall height power-pint smart board projector. Students have large sitting space in the canteen and metal benches are placed in all the walking area of the college for their convenience.
- Basket Ball Court, Badminton Court, Volleyball Court, Indoor Games space, a three floored hostel inside the college campus with 250 beds with a mess, its own common room, prayer room, temple, yoga Kendra, fully equipped gym, health care centre and doctor on call are there for the students' benefit.
- A manually protected parking lot is also there for the convenience of the students.
- Being placed in the centre of the city and within two kilometres range from the two bus stands it is easily accessible for the students to commute daily from nearby villages. Electrician, technicians, plumber etc. are available to cater to the related problems on emergency call.

Human Resource Management (2016-17)

- Out of the main HRM practices recruitment and selection are conducted by the Higher Services Commission in case of permanent employees because our college is an aided U.P. Govt. College affiliated to the CCS University.
- Our management starts from manpower planning, induction, socialization and training. The college management and the Principal along with the HODs and the Bursar make their best efforts in socializing the new recruits in the college atmosphere.
- All the academic staff members are motivated and supported in going ahead with their Career Development plans, including Orientation & Refresher Courses, seminars and workshops. The Compensation and Benefits part again is regulated by the Government rulings but no hindrance is created in allowing an employee's legal due.
- Their Performance Appraisals are noted in their service books by the Principal and feedback is taken from students and other related stakeholders by the Principal with help of the IQAC and department HODs.
- Regarding the Internal Mobility aspect there is no system of regular transfers in affiliated colleges but whenever the requirement for individual permanent transfer arises the Principal along with the management body do the needful, keeping in mind the college, students and the employee's benefits and loss.
- The grievance handling process is continuous in nature as we have a permanent grievance handling cell for the students and problems related to the academic and administrative staff are handled on a one to one basis. Also, the staff associations of both teaching and non-teaching employees as well as the students; union are very healthily active in the college getting their voice heard and action taken as soon as the problem arises.
- Regarding the employee-employer relationship, again as the recruitment process is from the Higher Services Commission basically all are government employees but a very healthy hierarchy system is maintained in our college with all the employees giving their right due to their posts and responsibilities assigned to them as well as to their superiors and subordinates and having very affable and smooth relationships with the management body.
- The overall effectiveness of human resources management practices in our college is shown in the work-culture, disciplined administration and democratic atmosphere in the college.

Action Taken Report

(2016-17)

IQAC team members are in regular contact with the Principal and College Management Committee to update them with the developments and progress made by the academic and administrative staff. They are also kept informed about the students' feedback and steps taken to solve their problems. They motivate the academic departments to accomplish their yearly plan of action well within the stipulated time and give its report timely to the IQAC.

Following is the summary of the activities undertaken by the college during the academic session of 2016-17:

- International, National and Regional level seminars were organized by various departments.
- Major & minor research projects were undertaken.
- Research work & publication of papers were encouraged and an atmosphere conducive to coordinate regular class room teaching with their research work activities was given to the faculty members.
- Almost every teacher from all departments attended international and national seminars and workshops organised by outside agencies and universities.
- Many post-PG students who have cleared their Ph.D. entrance exams have prepared ready-to-submit research proposals with the able guidance of their respective department faculty members. They undertook pre-Ph.D. courses initiated by the University.
- Teachers were encouraged to take part in Refresher and Orientation Courses.
- Many competitions were organised by the departments as part of the academic activities keeping the students' syllabi in mind, like PPT presentation of project works, symposia, group discussions, debates, extempore, quiz, creative writing –poem, short stories, essays in Hindi, English & Sanskrit, seminars, workshops, learned speakers' talks, celebration of national & international Days and festivals.
- A good many of co-curricular and extracurricular activities through inter-departmental and inter-collegiate competitions were organised in the college and a large number of students took part and won prizes in them.
- The units of NCC, Rangers and Sports students were given full support, facilities and encouragement to seek selections in state and national level presentations. Some of

them did score well, like, went for Republic Day Parade screening test, won international, national, state and university level prizes and shields.

- Girls eagerly participated in community development programs organised by the Community Development Cell, NCC, and Rangers' units.
- Two new Self Employment courses 'Office Automation' and 'E-Governance' and BPO are running under the Community College scheme of the UGC.
- The Career Counselling Cell and the Students' Welfare Association organised quite a number of industrial visits, MNC recruitment campaigns and training programmes.
- Departmental Associations organised study tours and guest lectures on topics related to their syllabi.
- Career-oriented short term courses initiated by the Computer Application and Food Sc. Departments as well as NIIT, were promoted by teachers by encouraging students in their class-rooms to take them up for becoming economically self-dependent.
- Traditional U.G. courses, B.A. & B. Com., were started by the distance education Special Study Centre for Women of IGNOU besides these two we have MPA. MAPY, DECE, MAPC, DNHE & MBA also. This gave an opportunity to those students to study in our college who could not get their names in the online merit list of the University gateway of admissions. These courses also provided more subject combination options to students who were not able to get their choice subjects due to non-availability of seats or less marks. Again these UG courses allowed flexibility in time for those students who wanted to continue in their jobs simultaneously because we hold IGNOU classes only on non-working days like Sundays.
- The Computer Centre, Language Labs, Library and various departments purchased Software's, Books & Journals, Equipments, Chemicals and Glassware's etc. from the maintenance and special grants for promoting quality work by the institution.
- A proposal for starting a separate Women Studies has been submitted and is under consideration to the UGC by the Home Science department.
- Regular renovations and furnishings, where required and needed were done and supplied. The whole college building structure (including the hostel premises) was repaired where damaged and was white washed.
- Special emphasis was given to adding seasonal flowers, medicinal plants, herbs and shrubs in the college compound. A lush lawn is maintained with two fountains working throughout the academic session.
- Hygienically prepared food items were served in the college canteen for the students and staff's convenience. The hostel mess prepared healthy food for the students under able supervision of the Principal, Chief Warden and her assistants.
- Toilets have been made for the students and staff members on every floor and building block of the college. They were kept clean by the cleaning staff on an hourly basis.

- Drinking water was also made available to the college members through water purifiers fitted in the water-coolers on every floor and block of the college building. Overhead water tanks were cleaned on monthly basis.

SWOT Analysis (2016-17)

Strengths:

1. 65 out of 70 permanent teaching faculty members are Ph. Ds. Therefore a high level of research oriented culture exists in the college.
2. Ever since NET, SLET and pre-Ph.D. Entrance have become a compulsory requirement for seeking a teaching career in the higher education the teachers concentrate upon the aspiring PG students in channelizing their academic energies towards these competitions along with their degree exams.
3. Every student who takes admission here, no matter what has been her background has been becomes expert in the use of computer and internet facility.
4. More than 60% of students come from villages and towns with a rural background where opportunities to brush up their speaking and writing skills are less. Keeping this in mind, the college has language labs both in English & Hindi and courses like Communicative English and Journalism are taught here to encourage girls to enrich their communicative skills.
5. The spirit of inclusiveness is seen in the mutual social conduct of students and teachers because work, diligence and dedication are the three personality assets of this college. There is no differentiation in behaviour on the basis of caste, community or economic status even in the administrative staff and the 4th class employees of the college.
6. The college is centrally located in the town and within 2 km range from the three bus stands which makes it easily accessible to the girls.
7. It has a large hostel inside the college premises and as it is a girls college parents of students from distant cities feel very safe in leaving their wards here.

Weaknesses:

1. Sustainable non-government endowments.
2. Obtaining patents for science-based innovations.
3. International collaborations in continuum.

Opportunities:

1. Developing links with international research organisations.
2. Establishing Chairs of famous national & international academic legends.

3. Initiating an independent women-centric study centre and obtaining permission from the government and UGC to introduce courses directly related to women awakening, empowerment and entrepreneurship.

Threats:

1. Developing a career-oriented approach in the girls in accordance with the ever growing need for women-self-dependence.
2. Motivating the parents to allow choices of courses to their daughters according to the latter's aptitude and interest instead of forcing long-tested traditional courses upon them.
3. Getting all the vacant posts of teaching /non teaching staff permanently filled so that the departments / administration may function without a break and give better results.
