# **Department of English**

Students will be able to understand the meaning, nature and scope of the International Relations. The programme provides the students with the capacity to identify issues and problems relating to the realization of human rights.

### **Department of Economics**

### Programme Outcome

To provide students a well-founded education in Economics, a structured curriculum which support the academic development of students and prepares our graduates and post graduates for employment and further study as economists. To hand over students with the opportunity to pursue courses that emphasize quantitative and theoretical aspects of Economics & also focuses on applied and policy issue in Economics.

Preparing students to become accomplished citizens and professionals capable of critical thinking and independent analysis is another aim fulfilled after studying Economics at Post graduate level as it integrates theory, politics, econometrics, mathematical economics and economic thought with application in a wide variety of fields within economics. A deep insight of finance and management sectors augments the soft skill of a student which makes him/her fit to face any challenge in public or private sector. The subject of economics would thus Help students seeking job opportunities in teaching and other professions that ask for this degree in economics.

# **Department of Home Science**

#### Programme Outcome

Home science has its own unique features which distinguishes itself from other subjects. It helps in improving the domestic skills of its students through knowledge in areas of housekeeping, food preservation, stitching, interior decoration, cookery, home decoration, child rearing etc. which is of wide application now a days. ## **Department of History**

### Programme Outcome

The Under Graduate course in History Major comprises of Ancient, Medieval and Modern Indian history, which can be further categorized into History of Science and Technology, Historiography, Sultanate period, Mughal period, India under the East India Company, Indian Freedom Movement. The course also includes European History (different periods) and International Relations. After the completion of MA, history scholars will be able to distinguish between primary and secondary sources and identify and evaluate evidence and demonstrate in discussion and written work their understanding of different peoples and cultures in past environments and of how those cultures changed over the centuries. They are also able to produce their own historical analysis of documents and develop the ability to think critically and historically when discussing the past. The Subject thus gives them the ability to compare and contrast different processes, modes of thoughts and modes of expression from different historical time periods and in different geographical areas by making the students capable of offering multi-causal explanations of major historical developments based on a contextualized analysis of interrelated political, social, economic, cultural and intellectual processes. It enables them to write an original research paper that locates and synthesizes relevant primary and secondary sources and has a clear, coherent and plausible argument, logical structure, proper references. Also, it would foster the skills to present orally their research or a summary of another's research in an organized, coherent and compelling fashion

Dissertation in the Subject enables Understanding of techniques and methods of presentation in History by the students by Preparation of preliminary bibliography Collection of Data, Presentation of findings and drafting the Dissertation.

### Programme Specific Outcomes

After completion of this course. the students gather knowledge about the socio-cultural heritage of India and world as well thus helping to grow national and international understanding among history students.

Careers options for students include engagement as educators, archivists, producers of multimedia material and even as a researcher in historic Sites and Museums, Historical Organizations, Cultural Resources Management and Historic Preservation etc as History helps them in knowing the past people, their culture, their religions, and their social systems and transforms them into responsible citizens to make a better future.

# **Department of Philosophy**

### Programme Outcome

# **Department of Geography**

They will understand general demographic principles and their patterns at regional and global scales and will be able to locate on a map major physical features, cultural regions, and individual states and urban centers. The knowledge in the subject will enable Students to understand global and regional patterns of cultural, political and economic institutions, and their effects on the preservation, use and exploitation of natural resources and landscapes.

### Programme Specific Outcome

The subject thus augments their knowledge of quantitative methods used by geographers and their ability to use statistical software to solve geographic problems as well as of physical geography and the methods and techniques for observing, measuring, recording and reporting on geographic phenomena.

After specialization in the subject the students would develop an understanding of current research within the breadth of geography, as well as more in-depth knowledge of research in their speciality areas, demonstrate an understanding of basic spatial statistics and multivariate quantitative and analytical methods, and other appropriate tools for spatial analysis, inculcate an understanding of the components of research design including problem definition, theory, literature review, methodology and analysis and would demonstrate significant research and writing expertise resulting in a meaningful scholarly contribution. Students would in this way be prepared to apply their skills in professional careers.

### **Department of Drawing and Painting**

#### Program Outcome

Students after graduation and post-graduation can be a professional Artist and land scape designer, illustrators, teacher, gallery director and art therapists. Many students can pursue business opportunities such as starting art galleries and working in designing firms.

### Program Specific Outcome

Postgraduate students of Zoology will specialize in the field of Fish and Fisheries which opens for them various research and enterpreunal fields besides going in for NET, GATE and other competitions exam.

## **Department of Chemistry**
