



The competition has **rules and guidelines** that participants need to follow to ensure fair and ethical competition.

- **Eligibility:** The competition is open to the students of college level.
- **Theme:** The theme typically focuses on waste management, recycling, and upcycling, and encourages participants to come up with innovative and sustainable solutions to reduce waste generation.
