Rules for Rangoli Competition

- Time will be one and a half hour.
- Size of rangoli should be 2^{ft} X 2^{ft}. Students can make it round or square shape.
- Kindly use auspicious colour.
- Students are free for material. They can use any medium or technique.
- College will not provide any material.
- Two participants can participate from each department or each college.

Rules for Best Out of Waste Competition

- Participants should bring their own material required for the competition.
- The item would be rejected if not found to be a waste product/second hand item.
- The time would be one and a half hours.
- Participants would be judged on creativity, utilization of resources, eco-friendly material, utility of the product & overall presentation.
- The decision of the judges would be considered final.
- Kindly send at least 2 entries from your department / institution till 10th Feb, 2023.

Rules for Essay Competition

- Time limit one hour.
- Words limit 2000 words (maximum).
- Two participants from each institutions / departments are allowed.
- Last date for entries 15th Feb.
- Sheets will be provided by the college.
- Medium Hindi and English both.

Rules for Extempore Competition

- Participants are requested to reach the college one hour in advance of the competition to register their names.
- Topics of the Extempore shall be given to the participants 15 minutes before time.
- The time limit of the Extempore is 2 minutes.
- No paper reading will be allowed.
- Participants can use either medium of Hindi or English.
- Decision of the Judges will be final.

Rules for Folk Song Singing Competition

- Number of girls students must be 6 to 8.
- The number of instruments must be 2 to 3 (select reciprocal instruments).
- Folk song must be of Indian and regional language.
- The costumes must be in line with the folk song.
- Use of offensive words is prohibited.
- Time duration is 5 to 7 minutes.
- You will have to make your own arrangements for the accompanists.
- Additional time of 3 minutes will be given for group's stage composition and checking of musical instruments and sound instruments (Mike), planning of accompanists etc.
- The decision of the jury will be final and valid.

Rules for Talent Hunt

- It would include any talent other than dancing and singing.
- It may include instrument playing (Indian / Western), mimicry, mono acting, mime.
- Any talent other from the above mentioned.
- Time given for display of talent may vary from 2 5 minutes.
- You have to bring your own instrument for participation.

Rules for Skit Competition

- The Theme of the Skit should be "Social/ Environment/ Comedy".
- The team participating in the skit should have a minimum of 5 members and a
- maximum of 8 members.
- The teams will be allowed a maximum of 2 minutes to prepare the stage and 10 minutes to perform.
- The Props will be arranged by the teams themselves (General furniture like table/chairs will be made available at event venue).
- No use of slangs and un-parliamentary language in the skit.
- The Competition will be judged on the basis of the script, facial expressions, and creative use of props, stage mannerism, co-ordination, voice modulation and overall performance.
- Final ratings shall be decided by aggregating points awarded by a panel of judges.
- In case of any dispute, decision of the organizers of the event shall be final and conclusive.

Rules for Group Dance Competition

- Number of girls students must be 6 to 8.
- The costumes must be in accordance with the folk dance.
- Time duration is 5 minutes.
- Folk dance must be of Indian and regional language.
- Use of film songs is prohibited.
- Use of songs with offensive words is prohibited.
- Bring your own song in pen drive.
- The decision of the jury will be final and valid.
