

MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING (MoU)

between

U.P. Rajarshi Tandon Open University and the Study Centre

This agreement is made on 25 (day) of 06 (month) 2021 (year) between U.P. Rajarshi Tandon Open University, Shantipuram, Sector-F, Phaphamau, Allahabad - 211 021 represented by the Registrar here-in-after referred to as 'UPRTOU' and this expression shall include the successors and assignees on one part and Raghunath Girls' P.G. College, (College/ Organization/Institute) Western Kutchery Road (address) Meerut - 250001 (place) represented by its Principal/Director and Manager herein after called Host Institution and this expression shall include their successors and assignees on the other part. Whereas the Host Institution has agreed to work as an approved Study Centre of the university and that UPRTOU agrees to permit the aforesaid Host Institution to run the Study Centre under the rules, regulations and norms laid down for such purposes.

1. The Host Institution undertakes to :

- (i) Provide rooms (space) for exclusive use of UPRTOU centre without charging any rent.
- (ii) Make available rooms for counselling sessions and also for University examinations in case the Study Centre is made an examination centre of UPRTOU.
- (iii) Permit the use of its library, laboratories and other institutional facilities without charging any extra fees.
- (iv) Help to generate awareness among public about UPRTOU and its programmes.
- (v) Install a signboard of UPRTOU Study Centre prominently at the gate and other proper places.
- (vi) Strictly adhere to the conditions laid down in the letter communicating the permission of the UPRTOU to establish a Study Centre in the Host Institution.

2. Uttar Pradesh Rajarshi Tandon Open University (UPRTOU) undertakes to :
- (i) Appoint a Co-ordinator recommended by the Principal/Director of the Host Institution.
 - (ii) Pay contingent charges to the Study Centre as per the norms of UPRTOU.
 - (iii) Pay honoraria and conveyance to the Co-ordinator of the Study Centre and Principal/Director of the Host Institution as per the norms of UPRTOU.
 - (iv) Appoint part time Assistant Co-ordinator approved by the university and pay to him/her honorarium and conveyance as per the norms of UPRTOU.
 - (v) Authorise the Principal/Director to appoint part time class III and class IV employees and other functionaries and pay them honoraria at the rate fixed by UPRTOU from time to time.
 - (vi) Pay honoraria and conveyance to the counsellors as per the norms of UPRTOU.
 - (vii) Pay contingent charges and other honoraria for holding UPRTOU examinations as per the norms of UPRTOU in case the Study Centre is made an examination centre of UPRTOU.
3. Under this memorandum of understanding, both the Host Institution and the University agree-
- (i) That they shall have the right to terminate the MoU by mutual agreement.
Or;
 - (ii) That one month's notice shall be required to be served on the Host Institution if there are proven lapses on the part of Host Institution in terms of irregularities in admissions or/and counselling or/and finances or/and examinations etc.
Or;
 - (iii) that three months notice shall be required to be served on UPRTOU by the Host Institution.

उ0प्र0 राजर्षि टण्डन मुक्त विश्वविद्यालय, प्रयागराज का अध्ययन केन्द्र स्थापित किये जाने हेतु आपके आवेदन-पत्र/प्रस्ताव पर गठित स्क्रीनिंग समिति की संस्तुति के आधार पर मा0 कुलपति जी के स्वीकृति के पश्चात् निम्नलिखित शर्तों के अधीन मान्यता प्रदान की जाती है :

1. अध्ययन केन्द्र समन्वयक को प्रवेश प्रक्रिया के दौरान 'पूर्व-प्रवेश परामर्श' की व्यवस्था करनी होगी। सभी प्रवेश, प्रवेश अर्हताओं के परीक्षण के पश्चात् करेंगे। गलत या अनर्ह शिक्षार्थियों को प्रवेश देने पर सम्पूर्ण उत्तरदायित्व अध्ययन केन्द्र के समन्वयक एवं प्राचार्य का होगा।
2. अध्ययन केन्द्र समन्वयक, ऑनलाइन प्रवेश और परीक्षा आवेदन-पत्र जमा करने हेतु निर्धारित अन्तिम तिथियों का अनुपालन करेंगे और ई-आवेदन फार्म में संलग्न अर्हता सम्बन्धित प्रमाण-पत्रों की सत्यता सुनिश्चित करते हुए कालेज लॉगिन आईडी से समय सीमा के अन्दर वेरीफाई करना सुनिश्चित करेंगे। कालेज लॉगिन से वेरीफाई होने पर ही नामांकन संख्या जनरेट होगी तथा शिक्षार्थी का डेटा पाठ्य सामग्री प्रेषण हेतु पाठ्य सामग्री अनुभाग के पोर्टल पर अग्रसारित हो जायेगा। विलम्ब के लिए केन्द्र समन्वयक उत्तरदायी होंगे।
3. अध्ययन केन्द्र समन्वयक यह सुनिश्चित हो लें कि विश्वविद्यालय द्वारा उनके अध्ययन केन्द्र पर आवंटित कार्यक्रमों में ही शिक्षार्थियों को प्रवेश दिया गया है। गैर अनुमन्य कार्यक्रमों में शिक्षार्थियों को प्रवेश देने पर अध्ययन केन्द्र की मान्यता बिना किसी पूर्व सूचना के निरस्त कर दी जायेगी।
4. अध्ययन केन्द्र समन्वयक प्रवेश आवेदन-पत्रों, बैंक परीक्षा आवेदन-पत्रों एवं अधिन्यास कार्य के सम्बन्ध में विश्वविद्यालय द्वारा समय-समय पर दिये गये निर्देशों के अनुसार कार्यवाही सुनिश्चित करेंगे।
5. अध्ययन केन्द्र संचालन के लिए विश्वविद्यालय मानकानुसार आपके अध्ययन केन्द्र पर प्रत्येक वर्ष शिक्षार्थियों की न्यूनतम संख्या 10 होनी चाहिए, अन्यथा की दशा में केन्द्र निलम्बित करते हुए प्रवेशित शिक्षार्थियों को अन्यत्र निकटतम अध्ययन केन्द्र पर स्थानान्तरित कर दिया जायेगा।
6. अध्ययन केन्द्र पर लगातार तीन सत्रों में प्रवेश संख्या शून्य होने पर अध्ययन केन्द्र को निष्क्रिय मानकर उसकी मान्यता निरस्त हो जायेगी। मान्यता निरस्त होने की स्थिति में अध्ययन केन्द्र एक वर्ष के अन्दर विश्वविद्यालय के समक्ष सम्बन्धित क्षेत्रीय केन्द्र से अदेयता प्रमाण-पत्र प्राप्त करने के बाद प्रतिभूति राशि प्राप्त कर सकता है। प्रतिभूति राशि पर विश्वविद्यालय द्वारा कोई ब्याज देय नहीं होगा।

2. The course type, duration, timings, fees, qualification, & course contents will be decided mutually between RGPG & PCE.
 3. The curriculum for the training courses will be approved by RGPG. Any course will be started after approval of RGPG.
 4. The certificates to successful trainees will be prepared & issued by PCE along with RGPG post completion of all required process like Attendance, Collection of Fee, Admission forms and Photographs, Feedback form etc.
 5. The details of training programmes including day and hour wise schedule will be submitted by PCE to RGPG post having a discussion with HODs to avoid clash of time.
 6. The feedback forms obtained from the trainees during training courses will be submitted to PGPG by PCE after the completion of concerned courses.
 7. The Net Revenue (Gross Revenue – Gross Expenses) share shall be in the ratio of 50:50 (50% of the net revenue shall be the share of RGPG & 50% of the net revenue shall be the share of PCE).
 8. Gross Expenses like Faculty's Salaries and other counselling staff Salaries & LTA involved in RGPG deployed by PCE.
 9. RGPG shall be responsible for collection of course fee from the enrolled students on behalf of the PCE, of which 50% of the amount shall be paid by RGPG to PCE within 7 days of the invoice submitted to RGPG by PCE. PCE shall raise the invoice on quarterly basis to RGPG.

Raghunath Girls' Post Graduate College, Meerut through its principal Prof. Nivedita Kumari (hereinafter referred to as "SECOND PARTY" which expression shall, unless repugnant to the meaning or context thereof, be deemed to mean and include its successors and permitted assigns) of the fellow party. The FIRST PARTY and the SECOND PARTY may hereinafter collectively be referred to as the "Parties" and individually as "Party".

The object of this Agreement is to support the deserving students of marginalized sections of society for avenues of Skill Upgradation Programs.

1.0 General Provisions

1.1 In the event of the First Party initiating a program or activity for which support is sought from the Second Party, it may inform, consult the First Party in order to harmonize the efforts, taking into account the responsibilities. Some of the specific areas for this harmonization are:

- Selection of deserving candidates for admission into various courses Screening Process.
- Basic Educational Qualification 12th Pass.
- Candidate above 18 to 30 years of age for Skill Courses.
- Rejection or Expulsion of students from the course Rejection or Expulsion Criteria.
- If the candidate's conduct is not as per rules and regulations as may be decided by the Parties in mutual consultation.
- If the candidate is found to be part of any illegal activity or any such activity that may adversely affect the goodwill and reputation of either of the Party.
- Such act / omission of the student as the Parties in mutual consultation deem necessary to take action of rejection/expulsion.

2.0 Roles and Responsibilities

In pursuance of the aforesaid objective, Parties agree to the following:

2.1 ROLES AND RESPONSIBILITIES OF THE FIRST PARTY

- 2.1.1 FIRST PARTY will provide the support of Navjyoti Foundation Delhi offline course curriculum, training, and certification to the SECOND PARTY and will be responsible for updating the course curriculum. FIRST PARTY being the authorized Coordinating officer of NIF Delhi shall open skill training courses to all the students enrolled at the SECOND PARTY, its alumni as well as community.
- 2.1.2 FIRST PARTY will provide the support of the trainer program providing the identified trainer the SECOND PARTY to teach the courses. Only certified trainers will be eligible to take the courses at their centers.
- 2.1.3 FIRST PARTY shall invite beneficiaries to attend Offline classes, conferences, expert group seminars, and other meetings or it is organized with reference to the particular course in which the students have been admitted.
- 2.1.4 FIRST PARTY shall not be responsible for the safety and security of students and the SECOND PARTY will be totally responsible to ensure that students attending training are safe during the class timings.
- 2.1.5 FIRST PARTY will pay the SECOND PARTY Rs. 50 for every student who clears the final exam successfully in the mentioned course within the stipulated time.
- 2.1.6 SECOND PARTY will ensure that the details pertaining to the newly started batches will be submitted to the FIRST Party within a week's period of time on the online admission portal of NIF.
- 2.1.7 FIRST PARTY will only register student names on the NIF portal following the physical verification of students at the declared approved location of the Second Party.
- 2.1.8 FIRST PARTY will have no bearing or relationship or accountability for any other activities run by the SECOND PARTY in and outside the central location other than the agreed courses.

2.1.9 FIRST PARTY will conduct the final online/offline examination as per the office order shared by the NIF admin team. The result sheet will be shared by FIRST PARTY within 10 days of receiving it from the NIF examination team.

2.1.10 In the event that the SECOND PARTY submits any fake enrollment list with Trackboons, the FIRST PARTY reserves the right to immediately terminate this agreement without notice. The FIRST PARTY may also pursue any legal remedies available to it under applicable law."

2.2 ROLES AND RESPONSIBILITIES OF THE SECOND PARTY

2.2.1 SECOND PARTY will be responsible to mobilize and enroll students at their center as per the mutually agreed schedule and timelines for admissions and selection of deserving candidates from the community for the offline course.

2.2.2 SECOND PARTY shall collect applications and identify deserving students from the different sections of society. The minimum strength of students to be maintained is 20@per batch for the above-agreed courses.

2.2.3 SECOND PARTY shall verify that the candidates identified are from different sections of society and who will have limited or least access to skill knowledge.

2.2.4 SECOND PARTY shall maintain a proper documentation record, attendance register and daily attendance on the portal for all the enrolled students

2.2.5 SECOND PARTY shall ensure to conduct baseline and end-line assessment of students. It shall also ensure that selected candidates are attending classes regularly online and shall do regular follow-ups of irregular students or dropout students and shall submit a status report to FIRST PARTY.

2.2.6 SECOND PARTY will inform the FIRST PARTY about the fee being charged to students for different skill courses.

2.2.7 SECOND PARTY shall not undertake any other activity simultaneously for the same students outside the campus and/or without the knowledge of the FIRST PARTY which may affect credibility and enrollments in the agreed course/courses.

2.2.8 SECOND PARTY shall not run similar activities in partnership with any other institute/s in the setup of FIRST party without dissolving the current agreement.

2.2.8 SECOND PARTY shall be responsible to hire qualified trainers for training programs. It shall be also responsible for the conduct and behavior of the trainers appointed by it for taking online/offline sessions for the courses in their community. THE SECOND PARTY shall totally follow the policies and procedures of the FIRST PARTY while executing the project.

2.2.9 SECOND PARTY shall facilitate the process of admission to the courses by regular follow-up with the parents of students selected.

2.2.10 SECOND PARTY will ensure that all the enrolled students have at least 85% average attendance during the duration of the course to appear in the final assessment after completion of the batch. THE SECOND PARTY will be accountable for the retention, data sanctity, and genuineness of students.

2.2.11 SECOND PARTY will share progress reports of students as well as the detail of the enrolled students on monthly basis to keep track record of students

2.2.12 SECOND PARTY will maintain a proper record of students' attendance registers and admission files offline and online.

2.2.13 The center will be open to monitoring visits and the SECOND PARTY will provide all the necessary support and cooperation for facilitating monitoring visits by the FIRST PARTY as per the mutually agreed schedule.

2.2.14 SECOND PARTY shall comply with all the norms of various policies of the FIRST PARTY including that of Child Protection, Sexual harassment, and other code of conduct. Any non-compliance shall result in the termination of the agreement with immediate effect. FIRST-PARTY will have no bearing or liability for the consequences arising out of noncompliance with these policies or any other illegal activities if indulged in by the SECOND PARTY.

3.0 MUTUAL BENEFITS OF BOTH THE PARTIES

- 3.1 Both Parties will promote this association through different activities to attract goodwill.
- 3.2 Both Parties may use their logos in their branding strategies to attract more deserving need-based students from the community.


4.0 ENTRY INTO FORCE, AMENDMENT, DURATION, AND TERMINATION

This Agreement shall come into effect upon signature of the Parties and shall remain so unless terminated by mutual agreement. This agreement will be effective initially for a minimum period of a year, w.e.f. from 12th September 2024 to 31st March 2025, from the date of the agreement. Upon the expiry of the initial period, Parties may mutually decide in writing at least 2 months prior to the Expiry Date to renew this Agreement.


4.0 IMPLEMENTATION AND MONITORING
